THE MAIN FIGURES OF THE GREEK HOTEL SECTOR IN SUMMER 2020

DESCRIPTION OF THE SURVEY

The sources of the data presented in this survey are the following:

❖ The registry of hotels that acquired their "Health First" Certificate by creating their Health Protocol through the Platform of the Hellenic Chamber of Hotels

The number of the above hotels amounted to **6.700** which intended with certainty to reopen after the lockdown.

❖ The weekly survey regarding the performance of the hotels after the lockdown

It is a weekly review on a 400 hotel-panel starting as of July 6, for recording the evolution of the main hotel indicators, in order to assess the impact of the Covid19 pandemic on the hotel sector.

❖ A short survey regarding the reopening dates of hotels after the lockdown

The survey took place among the 6.700 "Health First" certified hotels that intended to reopen, in order to define the reopening and the estimated closing dates of the hotels for the 2020 tourism season. The sample collected from this survey consisted of 2.455 hotels, representing 37% of the survey population.

OPERATING HOTELS FOR 2020

The total number of Greek hotels in operation during 2019 were 9.971






SEASONALLY OPERATING HOTELS

Weekly Evolution of Average Occupancy Rate (OR) of Total Greek Hotel Capacity, by Operation Mode



CONCLUDING REMARKS

In 2020, 60% of Greek hotels were open and operating

Average occupancy rate of total hotel capacity was estimated at 23%, during the peak-season quarter of July-September 2020

For the same period, the average room rate was estimated at 86 €

31% of year-round operating hotels that reopened after the lockdown, will be closed down by the end of 2020
