



The survey provides **weekly measures** on:


- Average Room Rate (ARR)

- Bookings
- Cancellations

Reference period: July – August – September 2020

Occupancy and Room Rates




Weekly Occupancy Rates (OR%) and Average Room Rates (ARR€)




Occupancy Rate Distribution




