

2015-2019



#### Percentage change of hotel capacity By Region, 2019/2015, (%)











#### Shares of hotel capacity by Region, 2019 (%)



- The average size, in terms of rooms, of hotels in Thasos in 2019 was 26 compared to Xanthi where the corresponding size was 38.
- The was no change (0%) in total number of rooms (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Kavala with only internal changes between hotel categories.



- The is no change (0%) in the total number of units and rooms (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Piraeus.





- There is no change (0%) in total number of rooms (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Samos with only internal changes between hotel categories.






- ➤ Regional Units Aetolia-Acarnania and Achaea have no 5\* hotels (2019).
- > Regional Unit of Ilia accounts for 41% of the rooms of the Region.
- Achaea is following with 38% and finally Aetolia-Acarnania with 21% of the rooms of the Region.
- The average hotel size of Ilia, in terms of rooms, is 47, Achaea's 35, while Aetolia-Acarnania's 26 (2019).
- An increase equal to 7% in terms of units and 13% in terms of rooms is recorded in Aetolia-Acarnania (2015-2019).

- There is no change (0%) in total number of units and rooms (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Kozani.



- > All the Regional Units of Epirus the 5-year period of the study(2015-2019) record positive changes in terms of units, rooms and beds.





- ➤ Regional Unit of Sporades accounts for 37% of the rooms of the Region.
- > Regional Unit of Magnisia is following with 31% of total rooms of the Region.
- > The average hotel size of Magnisia, in terms of rooms, is 18, while of Sporades is 37.
- > Regional Units of Karditsa, Larissa and Magnisia the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019) record small negative changes regarding their units, rooms and beds.
- Respectively, Regional Units of Sporades and Trikala record very small changes in hotel capacity.



# Data regarding Regional Units of Ionian Islands Region

- Regional Unit of Ithaca has no 5\* hotels (2019), while accounts for less than 1% of total rooms of the Region.
- > Corfu accounts for 48% of the rooms of the Region.
- > Regional Unit of Zakynthos (or Zante) is following with 35% of total rooms of the Region.
- The average hotel size of Ithaca, in terms of rooms, is 17, while in Corfu is around 61.
- > There is no change (0%) of hotel capacity (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Ithaca, concerning both total figures and hotel category distribution.
- All the other Regional Units of Ionian Islands the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019) record positive changes in terms of units, rooms and beds.





- > Regional Unit of Kilkis has no 4\* and 5\* hotels (2019), while accounts, respectively, for only 1% of total rooms of the Region.
- Regional Unit of Serres has no 5\* hotels (2019), while accounts, respectively, for only
   of total rooms of the Region.
- > Halkidiki accounts for 53% of the rooms of the Region.
- > Regional Unit of Pieria is following with 22% of total rooms of the Region.
- > The average hotel size of Pella, in terms of rooms, is 21, while of Thessaloniki is 56.
- $\succ$  There is no change (0%) in the total number of rooms (2015-2019) at the Regional Unit of Pieria, with changes only in terms of units and beds.





# Data regarding Regional Units of Crete Region



- > Regional Unit of Chania accounts for 32% of the rooms of the Region.
- Regional Units of Heraklion and Lasithi are following with 29% of total rooms of the Region.
- The average hotel size of Chania, in terms of rooms, is 46, while of Heraklion is 76.
- All Regional Units of Crete the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019) record positive changes in terms of units, rooms and beds.
- At the Regional Unit of Heraklion, a positive change equal to 6% is recorded concerning the number of hotel units from 2015 to 2019 (12% increase in terms of rooms).





# Data regarding Regional Units of South Aegean Region



- $\triangleright$  Regional Unit of Tinos has no 5\* hotels (2019), while accounts only for 1% of total rooms of the Region.
- >Rhodes accounts for 45% of the rooms of the Region.
- > Kos is following with 24% of total rooms of the Region.
- > The average hotel size of Milos, in terms of rooms, is 19, while of Kos is 96.
- > At the Regional Unit of Mykonos, the increase in terms of units (2015-2019) is equal to 10% (13% in terms of rooms).
- > At the Regional Units of Andros and Milos negative changes in the number of units, rooms and beds, are recorded the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019).



# Data regarding Regional Units of Peloponnese Region



- > Regional Unit of Argolida accounts for 28% of the rooms of the Region.
- Messinia is following with 27% of total rooms of the Region.
- > The average hotel size of Arkadia, in terms of rooms, is 17, while of Korinthia is 39.
- At the Regional Unit of Lakonia the increase in terms of units (2015-2019) is equal to 17% (20% in terms of rooms).
- At the Regional Units of Argolida and Korinthia negative changes in the number of units, rooms and beds, are recorded the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019).





- > Regional Unit of Fokida has no 5\* hotels (2019).
- > Regional Unit of Evia accounts for 57% of the rooms of the Region.
- Regional Unit of Phthiotida is following with 18% of total rooms of the Region.
- > The average hotel size of Evritania, in terms of rooms, is 22, while of Evia is 36.
- > Small changes in hotel capacity are recorded in both Regional Units and Region in total, the 5-year period of the study (2015-2019).





#### CONCLUSIONS

- A constant upgrade trend is recorded regarding hotel capacity. In 2019, 3 highest categories accounted for 50%, compared to 43% in 2015.
- Between 2015 and 2019 hotel capacity increased by 2,5% in terms of units and by 7,2% in terms of rooms.
- Regarding hotel categories, the highest increase (48%) was recorded by 5\* hotels.
- At Regional level, the highest increase was recorded in South Aegean (11%), followed by Epirus (10%).
- In 2019 the share of seasonally operating hotels was equal to 59%, increased by 5 percentage units compared to 2015.
- Country's islands account for more than 50% of total hotel capacity.



79% of total hotel capacity has hotel size up to 50 rooms.
