






HOTEL CAPACITY IN 2024




- 73% of hotels belong to the 1-3 categories,




73% of hotels have a capacity of up to 50 rooms

62% of hotels operate seasonally, accounting for 74% of the total room capacity.


LOCATION



53% of hotels are located in the country's island destinations, with the corresponding share i terms of rooms reaching 63%.




THE EVOLUTION OF HOTEL CAPACITY, 2015–2024





THE EVOLUTION OF HOTEL CAPACITY, 2015–2024, BY CATEGORY







PERIOD OF OPERATION - DEFINITIONS

- ❖ The operating period, for seasonal hotels, is the period during which the hotel was in operation, and it is measured in months. (5,7 months means 5 months and 7/10 = 21 days).
- ❖ It is used as an indicator of the seasonality of Greek tourism.

The operating period of seasonal hotels remained unchanged from 2023 to 2024 and shows consistency across categories.





HOTEL OCCUPANCY RATE - DEFINITIONS


- ❖ The occupancy rate is defined for a specific month of the reference year (e.g., May, August) and is calculated as the ratio of actual overnight stays in occupied rooms to the maximum possible overnight stays. For example, in a hotel with 20 rooms, the maximum number of overnight stays in August is $B = 20 \times 31 = 620$. The total number of overnight stays recorded during the same period is A (where A ≤ B), and the occupancy rate is calculated as A/B. This ratio is typically expressed as a percentage, using the formula: $(A/B) \times 100\%$.
- RIT's annual survey examines the occupancy rate for three months (May, August, and October), reflecting the average monthly occupancy rate in terms of rooms, as reported by each hotel.







Average Hotel Occupancy Rate by month, 2023-2024







Average Hotel Occupancy Rate by category, May – August – October 2024










Average Hotel Occupancy Rate by operation, May – August – October, 2022- 2024









AVERAGE ROOM RATE - DEFINITION

❖ The prices presented in the annual survey refer to the average rate of a double room during the three months reviewed. (May, August, October).







Average Rate of a Double Room May – August – October, 2022-2024



The average rate of a double room in **August 2024** remained stable compared to August 2023.

For the months of May and October, a small but consistent increase of approximately 6% was recorded between 2023 and 2024.







Average Rate of a Double Room by operation May – August – October, 2022-2024








In 2024, a significant **increase** was observed in the average rate of a double room at **year-round hotels**, particularly during the months of **May** and **October**.





Distribution of Average Rate of a Double Room August 2024



From the distribution of double room disposal rates in August 2024, as shown in the chart, the following results are obtained:


- > 25% of the rooms are available up to 80€.
- > 50% of the rooms are available up to 130€.
- > 75% of the rooms are available up to 216€.
- > The central 50% of the rooms (within the golden frame) are available from 80€ to 216€.

➤ In 2024, hotel turnover increased by 8,8% compared to the previous year.



- ➤ Hotels in the 1*-3* categories, which represent 74% of all hotels, recorded a **5,0**% turnover increase in 2024 compared to 2023.
- ➤ Hotels in the 4*-5* categories recorded a 10% increase in turnover compared to the previous year.



Number of hotel Salaried Employees, 2024 compared to 2023




- ➤ Employment in 2024 remains at high levels, exceeding 198.000 jobs and sustaining the sector's strong momentum.
- 13,7% of employees in Greek hotels come from tourismrelated educational institutions.

- Annual investments for 2024 exceeded €1 billion.
- > 4,7% of hoteliers have received subsidies for these investments.

Nearly **€200 million** were spent by hoteliers on **sustainability initiatives**.

The share of investments allocated to sustainability actions saw a significant increase in 2024, reaching approximately 19% of total investments, compared to 13,3% in 2023.







Average percentage of foreign customers in hotels in 2024

69,2%

was the average percentage of foreign tourists in Greek hotels in 2024, which is at about the same level as in the recent years.









The Multiplier Effects of the Hotel Sector on the Greek Economy in 2024



The Multipliers of the Hotel Sector

A recent study by RIT on the contribution of the hotel sector to the Greek economy estimated the following multipliers for output, employment, and imports.

Total Contribution of the Hotel Sector to the Greek Economy 2024

- ➤ The total contribution to Greece's economic output is at €17.814,9 million.
- In 2024, the hotel sector accounted for 5,9% of the country's GDP, up from 4,8% in 2023.







Total Contribution of the Hotel Sector to the Employment of the Greek Economy 2024

- ➤ For every **€1 million** increase in demand for hotel services, total employment in the Greek economy rises by **30** jobs.
- ➤ In 2024, the hotel sector supported 143.000 indirect jobs across other sectors of the Greek economy. Notably, 27.704 of these jobs were newly created employment positions.
- In total, the hotel sector supported over **340.000** jobs in 2024, both directly and indirectly.
- Compared to 2023, the hotel sector contributed an additional **27.704** jobs to the Greek economy in 2024.







Total Contribution of the Hotel Sector to the External Sector of the Greek Economy 2024

- Foreign tourists, who represent 69,2% of hotel guests, contribute approximately to 85% of total hotel turnover.
- ➤ The hotel sector is estimated to have improved Greece's external balance by around €7,9 billion.












Distribution of customer bookings through the various Channels: 2023 - 2024









Signing of Contracts for 2025



- ➤ Half of the hotels have already signed contracts for 2025, at similar levels to those of 2024.
- Among seasonal hotels, 60% have signed contracts for 2025 (up from 55%) in 2024). Of these, 41% (compared to 72% in 2024) have signed contracts with an 8% price increase, as was the case last year.
- Among the seasonal hotels that have signed contracts for 2025, 34% have entered into Commitment-type agreements, allocating 56% of their room capacity—unchanged from the previous year.







The main difficulties faced by hoteliers in 2024



The main difficulties faced by hoteliers in 2024 were:

- Finding employees, and
- the cost of energy.

Concerns remain about:

- The operating costs,
- the reduced occupancy rate outside the peak months,
- staff shortage
- and the competition from short-term rental accommodations.







Conclusions





Conclusions (1)

- Over the past decade, the number of hotel establishments increased by only 4%, corresponding to an 11% rise in room terms. However, there has been a significant upgrade in hotel capacity, with a notable rise in 4* and 5* hotels.
- Hotel turnover in 2024 increased by 8,8% compared to 2023, reaching €11,5 billion.
- Employment in the sector remains high in 2024, with around 200.000 jobs supported.







Conclusions (2)

- There is a stabilization trend of tourist activity during peak months, with occupancy and prices remaining at levels similar to previous year.
- There is a clear trend of enhancing tourist movement during the off-peak months, reflected in higher occupancy and room rates among year-round hotels.
- Total investments in 2024 exceeded €1 billion, representing 9% of total hotel turnover.
- Investments in sustainability initiatives are estimated at €200 million, accounting for 19% of total hotel investments.







Conclusions (3)

- In 2024, the hotel sector contributed a total of €17.814,9 million to Greece's economic output, representing 5,9% of GDP, up from 4,8% in 2023.
- The hotel sector supported over **340.000 jobs**, both directly and indirectly, with 42% of these being indirect positions generated in other ssectors of the economy.
- Finally, as an export-oriented industry, the hotel sector contributed to improving Greece's external balance by approximately €7,9 billion.







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
